Mayer Water Co. has been in compliance, one of the few that has been.

The wells that are not in use have had their electrical service cut off, in order to save the monthly Basic Service Charge. JB connected up the second well at the Grapevine and both are now working. The pump on the Putnam #2 well at Poland Junction had a choke on the line to cut the volume. We removed the choke and put a timer on this one to save on electricity and wear on the pump.

Question by Clerk Houser as to our ability to meet our obligations after we start paying the Albins on the contract. Dunham reported that there is adequate income for this purpose.

The meters were read by a 2 man team at  $\pm 15.00$  per hour. It took them 15 hours. All meters were read properly.
