Mike King made a motion to waive the water deposit for the Mayer Chamber of Commerce, Duane Hines seconded, the Board voted, motion carried.
- D.) Discussion/Decision on Mayer Water District joining the Mayer Chamber of Commerce was tabled.
- E.) Approval of a Resolution to proceed with the line extension and new tank site was tabled.
- F.) Discussion/Decision on possible leak adjustment for Roy Berliew was tabled.
- G.) The Manager informed the Board of Mr. Stephen O'Bresly's application for new service and recommended the Board consider waiving part of the new service fees. Duane Hines made a motion to authorized the Manager to discuss this with Mr. O'Bresly and waive the appropriate fees, Mike King seconded, the Board voted, motion carried.
